Obituary of Ann Shumway

Funeral services for Ann L. Shumway, 95, were 1:30 p.m. Friday, Mar. 6, at First Congregational U.C.C., Hartington. Rev. Robert Neu officiated. Burial was in the Greenwood Cemetery, Wayne.

Ann L. Shumway was born Dec. 13, 1896 to Henry and Elizabeth (Beckenhauer) Giese at Wakefield. She died Monday, Mar. 2, 1992 at the Hartington Nursing Center, Hartington. She is a 1915 graduate of Wayne High School and a graduate of Wayne State Teacher's College. Ann married Lloyd C. Gildersleeve June 9, 1915 at Wayne. Mr. Gildersleeve died Nov. 25, 1918. She married Jeremiah "Jay" Shumway May 26, 1926 at Wayne. He died Apr. 14, 1980.

As a young girl her family moved north of Wayne. She moved to Mapleton, Ia. after her second marriage. They moved to Hartington in 1931 where Mr. Shumway managed Carhart-Shumway Lumber Yard.

Mrs. Shumway was a member of First Congregational U.C.C., the Women's Fellowship Group, charter member of HZ Chapter PEO, Areme Chapter of Order of Eastern Star, American Legion Auxiliary Post #4. Hartington VFW Auxiliary Post #5283 and a former board member of the Hartington Telephone Co. She is survived by a daughter and son-in-law, Arnold and Twila Anderson, Hartington; a son and daughter-in-law, Lloyd and Audie Gildersleeve, Rockport, Mo.; five grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, both husbands, a brother, Levi Giese; three sisters, Lydia McGuire, Laura Erickson and Lavina Arends.
