

Adeline Calkins Eddy 1833-1925

The death of Mrs. Adeline Eddy occurred, Tuesday about 1:30 p. m. at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Dorothy J. Richards, West Hanover street, Marshall. For the past two years Mrs. Eddy has been failing in health due to her advanced age. Mrs. Eddy was born at Monroe, July 1, 1833. She had spent most of her life in Toledo until six years ago when she came to Marshall to live with her daughter. Mrs. Eddy is survived by the daughter at whose home she died, four grandchildren and four great grandchildren and also one brother, Robert Calkins of Monroe.
