Pioneer Over Divide = Capitalist and Large Property Owner Succumbs at the Age of Eighty Years

C W Harvey, 80 years of age, a capitalist and owner of considerable real estate in this county, died at the family home, "Orange Orchard," in Whittier yesterday morning after a short illness. Funeral services will be conducted at 3 o'clock this afternoon in the chapel at Rosedale Cemetery.

Mr Harvey was the grandfather of the late Churchill Harvey-Elder, formerly assistant city editor of the Times, who was one of the victims of the explosion which wrecked the original Times Building and killed twenty employees.

Mr Harvey leaves a widow, a daughter, Emma Harvey-Elder; grand-daughter Mrs Grace Shorb; and a great grand-daughter, Miss Lucy Shorb.
