

# Ellen Margaret Ford Lucking 1833-1906

**MRS. E. M. LUCKING DEAD**  
*Born 1833-1833*  
**MOTHER OF FORMER CONGRESS-  
 MAN SUCCUMBS.**

Ellen M. Lucking, widow of the late Joseph Lucking, died yesterday at the home of her son, George W. Lucking, 260 Farnsworth avenue, aged 73 years. Mrs. Lucking had been a confirmed invalid for the last eight years and her death was not unexpected. She was born at Cornwall, Ont. Her father, Henry Ford, was the architect of the first government building erected at Toronto. For some years after her marriage she resided in Canada, going to Ypsilanti in 1858, where she spent the greater portion of her life.

Mrs. Lucking is survived by three sons, former Congressman Alfred Lucking, Receiver of Taxes Thomas M. Lucking and George W. Lucking.

Funeral services will be held at her son's home, 260 Farnsworth avenue, today at 5 o'clock. The interment will be at Ypsilanti Sunday.
