Mrs. R.W. Burnett is Dead in Denver

The body will arrive in Mattoon Monday morning at 11:25 o'clock on the Big Four railroad and will be taken to the Peers mortuary, where funeral services will be held at 2:30 o'clock Monday afternoon. Rev. Leslie Wilson of Trinity Episcopal church will officiate. Burial will follow in Dodge Grove.

Mrs. Burnett was about 60 years old, a daughter of the late Mr. And Mrs. C.C. Robinson. She and Mr. Burnett left Mattoon about 20 years ago and for a number of years resided in Dallas, Tex. They moved to Denver about 10 years ago. Besides her husband she leaves a son, George R. Burnett, of Denver, and a sister, Mrs. Edward Baker of Centralia.
