

# Irving Andrew Everett 1859-1936

## Former Lyons Resident Dies

Irving Andrew Everett, a former resident of Lyons, passed away at his home at Kalispell, Montana, on Monday, September 14. The body was brought to Lyons for burial and funeral services were held Sunday afternoon.

### Obituary

Irving Andrew Everett was born January 22, 1859, in central Minnesota, and departed this life September 14, 1936, at the age of 77 years, 7 months and 22 days.

When at the age of one year old his parents moved to Allamakee county, Iowa, where they resided for about five years, then they moved to Burt county, Nebraska, when he spent the greater part of his life.

In 1892 he moved to Ganado, Texas, where he resided for five years, moving back to Lyons for a stay of about three and one-half years. He then moved to Kalispell, Montana, where he lived until his demise.

In 1879 he was united in marriage to Adella Courtwright, who departed this life in 1883. To this union one son, Seth, was born.

In the year 1886 he was united in marriage to Minnie Dawson. To this union seven sons and one daughter were born. All the children survive excepting one son, who preceded his father in death.

Other immediate relatives who survive are Mrs. Tressie Paine and Mrs. Isabelle Roscoe, both of Lyons. One brother, Arthur Everett of Los Angeles, California, also survives.

Funeral services were conducted from the home of his nephew, Irving Roscoe of Lyons, Sunday afternoon at 1:30. Burial took place in the Lyons Cemetery.
