FORMER BITTER ROOT MAN TAKEN BY SUDDEN DEATH

Friends and relatives in the Bitter Root of Joy A. Martin were shocked to learn of his sudden death in a hospital at Everett, Wn. March 1. Details are lacking, though it is known his health had not been good. Funeral services were held at Everett.

Joy was born at Gibbonsville, Ida; April 10, 1902 and lived at Hamilton for a number of years when a boy, going to Washington State to make his home in 1923. Those who survive the deceased are his widow, three sons, his aunt and, uncle, and several cousins. The children are Lloyd in the Navy, Jack and Leonard. The latter served in the Army and for a time was a prisoner of the Nazis. His uncle and aunt are J.V. Burnett and Mrs. Olla Iddings, well known Bitter Rooters
