

Margaret Metzler Lyon 1846-1909

Lyons [NE] "Mirror", April 1909. The sudden death Saturday morning of Mrs. Waldo H. Lyon was a great shock to everybody. Mr. Lyon was in Mexico but is now on the way home.

Margaret Ann Metzler was born in Alleghany. Pennsylvania, April 17, 1846, and fell to sleep April 10, 1909 aged 62 years 11 months and 23 days. She came with her parents to Arizonia, Burt Co., in 1866, and was married to Waldo H. Lyon, near Decatur, Feb'y 22, 1872. Mr. and Mrs. Lyon settled in Lyons and made it their permanent home. Mrs. Lyon united with the Presbyterian church in 1893. Three sons were born to Mr. and Mrs. Lyon, two of whom, Fred and Burt, survive; who with the husband and a niece, who has been as a daughter in the home, remain to mourn her sudden decease. Two brothers, Charles A. and James M., and two sisters, Mary A. Black, and Mrs. H. W. Monroe, are living. The funeral service was held at the home on Tuesday afternoon, conducted by Rev. B.F.
