Resident of Montana for 35 Years is Dead

MRS. MARY BURNETT, WHO CAME TO MISSOULA IN 1883, MOURNED BY MANY

Hamilton, April 29.— Mrs. Mary Burnett, wife of J. J. Burnett and a resident of Montana for 35 years, died at 4 o'clock yesterday afternoon at the home of her daughter, Mrs. W. P. Iddings, west of this city. Death was due to heart failure ... decline.

The funeral will be held from Mrs. Idding's home 2 o'clock tomorrow afternoon. Rev. E.C. Spencer, pastor of the First Methodist Episcopal church officiating. Interment will be in Riverview cemetery.

Mrs. Burnett was 72 years of age and was a native of Ohio. She was married 53 years ago to Mr. Burnett and in December, 1878, came to Montana. In 1883 the family located at Missoula, where she lived for many years. For a number of years she lived near Hamilton. She had been a member of the Methodist church 56 years at the time of her death.

The deceased is survived by a husband and four children. The children are Mrs. W. P. Iddings, Mrs. Mamie Martin and Mrs. B. E. Storr of Hamilton and James V. Burnett, the well-known contractor and builder of Stevensville
