

Mary Eddy 1856-1948

Mrs. Mary Eddy, 91

Died at 8:15 a. m. Feb. 7 in the Ada Nursing Home. Death was sudden and attributed to an attack of heart disease.

One of Hardin county's oldest residents, she was born in Logan county July 1, 1856, daughter of Isaiah and Sarah Oglesbee-Quick, and formerly resided in Kenton where she was a member of the First Evangelical Reformed church. Her husband, Jonathan Eddy, preceded her in death in 1941.

Mrs. Eddy is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Arthur Brewer, of Ada; two sons, Harold Eddy of Ada and Cra E. Eddy of Bellefontaine; two sisters, Mrs. Lem Loughman and Mrs. Jacob Dunson of Ridgeway; four grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren. A son, Paul Eddy, and a daughter, Mrs. Watt Lieurance, are deceased.

Funeral services were held Monday and burial was made in Grove cemetery at Kenton.
