Walter Everett Dies in California

Walter Everett, age 88, son of the late Franklin and Clara Everett, pioneer residents of Lyons, died at his home in Los Angeles, California, Thursday, December 13. He was born April 12, 1857.

Mr. Everett and wife left Lyons to make their home in California about 40 years ago but while not a resident of Lyons he maintained a financial interest here and was the owner of considerable farm property. He continued to come to Lyons several times a year to visit his relatives and look after his business interests.

He, with his father, founded the Farmer's Bank in Lyons and was engaged in the banking business until he moved to the west.

There are no survivors of the immediate family; one sister, Mrs. W. S. Newmyer, two brothers, E. B. Everett and Fremont Everett, preceded him in death. He is survived by his wife and one daughter, Mrs. Verene Horne, of Los Angeles, California.

The funeral services were held Saturday, December 16, at Los Angeles, California.
